

**ORDINANCE NO. 06-04**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
WEISENBERG, LEHIGH COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE  
ORDINANCE REGULATING FIREWORKS  
AND FIREWORK DISPLAYS**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Weisenberg has adopted an Ordinance Establishing Rules and Regulations for Fireworks and Firework Displays, known as Ordinance No. 03-03 adopted on September 8, 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to amend Ordinance No. 03-03.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Township of Weisenberg, in lawful fashion duly assembled, as follows:

**SECTION 4 – FEE REQUIREMENTS, CONDITIONS, INSURANCE** shall be amended to add Subparagraph (f) to provide as follows:

(f) The applicant shall be responsible for, and shall pay, all charges related to fire protection, including the presence of a fire truck at the event, whether such charge is imposed by a volunteer fire company or a municipality.

An escrow deposit to secure payment of the required amount shall be required and the Supervisors shall determine the amount of the escrow.

**GENERAL REPEALER**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances, and all resolutions or parts of resolutions, inconsistent herewith shall be and are herewith repealed.

**SEVERABILITY**

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any provision, sentence, clause, phrase, section or part thereof shall for any reason be found unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, sections, or parts thereof, but the same shall remain in effect. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Township of Weisenberg that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part included herein.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective on the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) day following enactment.
